

Frequently Asked Questions

Find answers to common questions about our wedding packages, venue amenities, booking process, and more to help make your special day stress-free.

Q: Do you offer catering supplies?

A: No, you are responsible for any decorations, linen, glassware, dinnerware, cutlery, and other equipment

Q: Is there anything that we can't have on site?

A: For the health and safety of our animals, we don't allow confetti at any event on the site. However, organic materials such as real flower petals, birdseed, or rice are acceptable

Q: Are there any restrictions on decorating?

A: Inside the historic buildings, not use hooks, nails, pins, tape or other fasteners on the walls or artifacts

Q: Do we need event insurance?

A: Yes. You need to have special event liability insurance with the *Friends of Sunnybrook Farm Society* named as an additional insured. The museum needs a copy at least one week before the event.

Q: What is your cancellation policy?

A: Kindly inform us promptly if you need to cancel or reschedule your booking. Please note that cancellations will forfeit the damage deposit, and cancellations made within one week of the event will result in the loss of the full payment.

Q: Can we feed the animals?

A: Please do not feed the animals.

Q: Do we need a liquor permit?

A: If you intend to serve alcohol, you will need a permit. The museum needs a copy at least one week before the event, and a copy must be displayed at your bar.
